



Information clause

MARKETING

In order to fulfill the information obligation under Article 13 section 1 and section 2 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) (Journal of Laws EU L.2016.119.1, amended by Journal of Laws EU.L.2018.127.2), hereinafter referred to as GDPR - in connection with the acquisition of your personal data, we inform that:

1. 3. Your personal data will be processed in order to provide you with information on events, industry meetings, and conferences, including press conferences organized by the Data Controller and to send you invitations to these events.
4. The legal basis for your personal data processing is Art. 6 section 1 letter a of GDPR (i.e. your prior consent to the processing of personal data for this purpose in the field covered by this consent).
5. You have the right to request access to your personal data, its rectification, deletion, or restriction of the processing, as well as the right to submit an objection against the processing and the right to oppose any further processing and the right to transfer the data. If the processing of personal data is conducted on the basis of Art. 6 section 1 letter



a of GDPR, you have the right to withdraw your consent at any time with no impact on the lawfulness of the processing conducted on the basis of consent given prior to its withdrawal.

6. You have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority (i.e. the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection).
7. The provision of data is voluntary, but necessary to achieve the purposes set out in point 3. If you do not provide the data, you will not receive information and invitations referred to in point 3.
8. The data provided by you will not be disclosed to third parties. The recipients of the data will be bodies and institutions authorized to obtain data on the basis of applicable law and entities that will process data on our behalf, e.g. external public relations companies. In addition, your personal data will be disclosed to authorized persons employed by the Data Controller on the basis of employment contracts or civil-law contracts.
9. Your personal data will not be subject to automated decision making, including profiling.
10. The Data Controller does not intend to transfer personal data to a third country or international organization.
11. Your personal data will be kept for the period necessary to achieve the purposes set out in point 3 unless you withdraw your consent to the processing beforehand.
