

Information clause TRAINING

In order to fulfill the information obligation under Article 13 section 1 and section 2 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) (Journal of Laws EU L.2016.119.1, amended by Journal of Laws EU.L.2018.127.2), hereinafter referred to as GDPR - in connection with the acquisition of your personal data, we inform that:

- 1. - 3. Your personal data will be processed for the purpose of the training to ensure the protection and safety at the Rzeszów Ulma Family Airport Ltd
- 4. The legal basis for the processing of your personal data is Art. 6 section 1 letter c of GDPR (due to the fact that the processing is necessary to fulfill the legal obligations incumbent upon the Data Controller, under applicable law (in particular contained in the Act of 3 July 2002 Air Law, in the regulation of the Minister of Transport, Construction and Maritime Economy of 31 July 2012 on the National Civil Aviation Security Program, in the regulation of the Minister of Transport, Construction and Maritime Economy of 25 July 2013 on the National Quality Control Program for the protection of civil aviation, in the implementing regulation of the Commission (EU) No. 2015/1998 of 5 November 2015



- laying down detailed measures for the implementation of the common basic standards of civil aviation security).
- 5. You have the right to request access to your personal data, its rectification, deletion, or restriction of the processing, as well as the right to submit an objection against the processing and the right to oppose any further processing and the right to transfer the data.
- 6. You have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority, i.e. President of the Office for Personal Data Protection).
- 7. The provision of data is voluntary but necessary for the above-mentioned purpose. If you do not provide the data, it will not be possible for you to take part in the training.
- 8. The data provided by you will not be disclosed to third parties. The recipients of the data will be bodies and institutions authorized to obtain data on the basis of applicable law, e.g.: Border Guard, Civil Aviation Office, entities that will process data on our behalf, e.g. external training companies. In addition, your personal data will be disclosed to authorized persons employed by the Data Controller on the basis of employment contracts or civil-law contracts.
- 9. Your personal data will not be subject to automated decision making, including profiling.
- 10. The Data Controller does not intend to transfer personal data to a third country or international organization.
- 11. Your personal data will be kept for the period necessary to demonstrate your rights and qualifications in the implementation of security-related tasksand civil aviation security.
